The pieces on this album are partly standards from the Broadway repertoire like "Night & Day" or "But Beautiful". Others such as "Someday My Prince Will Come" or "Estate" were written later and became standards. Finally, the title "En La Orilla Del Mundo" comes from South American culture, to which I am very attached through my Hispanic roots.

For me, these pieces have several points in common: strong and singular melodies, as well as harmonic frameworks that are sufficiently interesting and flexible to allow the jazzman that I am to express himself.

My manner of interpreting these works is to stay quite close to the original composition, without artifice, while adding a personal touch.

For the recording of this album, I wanted there to be spontaneity, so I decided to select pieces that we had never played together before.

I hope that you will enjoy our interpretations, that you will hear our voices in them, and that these melodies will seduce you as they seduced me.

Les morceaux de cet album sont en partie issus du répertoire de Broadway, ce qu'on appelle des standards, comme "Night & Day" ou "But Beautiful". D'autres tels que "Someday My Prince Will Come" ou "Estate" ont été écrits plus tard et sont devenus des standards. Finalement le titre "En La Orilla Del Mundo" vient de la culture Sud-Américaine, à laquelle je suis très attaché par mes racines hispaniques.

Ces pièces ont plusieurs points en commun à mes yeux : des mélodies fortes et singulières, ainsi que des grilles harmoniques suffisamment intéressantes et souples pour permettre au jazzman que je suis de s'exprimer.

Ma manière d'interpréter ces œuvres est de rester assez proche de la composition originale, sans artifice, tout en y ajoutant une touche personnelle.

Pour l'enregistrement de cet album, je souhaitais qu'il y ait de la spontanéité. J'ai donc décidé de sélectionner des morceaux que nous n'avions encore jamais joués ensemble.

J'espère que notre interprétation vous plaira, que vous y entendrez notre voix propre, et que ces mélodies vous séduiront comme elles m'ont séduit.
