In a quiet corner of Café Ritorno, Stockholm, I met Saman. I had just arrived after twenty years in Istanbul, searching for a musician who could understand my tunes. It was an instant connection.

We rushed back to my small Vasastan apartment, and our music flowed effortlessly, like water. From there, we created, recorded, and journeyed through Israel and Turkey, eventually crafting our album.

But our bond is more than music. It's the story of my parents, Jewish immigrants from Baghdad to Israel in the 1950s, and Saman, a Jewish soul who found his way to Sweden from Kurdistan \ Iraq over twenty years ago during Saddam Hussein's rule.

Together, we named our project "2gether," symbolizing the unity of two worlds. We hope our music finds a special place in your heart.
